Neurodivergent individuals possess a wide range of skills, talents, and unique perspectives that are often overlooked or undervalued in mainstream employment settings. In an effort to create a space for the ND community to buy, sell, and trade their goods and services—without many of the constraints and inequalities found in traditional capitalist systems—we are launching an ND Marketplace at this year's festival! This document outlines the steps to participate.

- PARTICIPATION DETAILS -

Participation Fee: \$25

The cost to participate in the Neurodiverse Marketplace is \$25.00* and payment is due upon acceptance of your application.

* Worried about costs? You can indicate on your application if you would like to be considered for financial assistance!

Vendor Requirements

To help ensure the promotion of neurodivergent initiatives, all ND Marketplace Vendors must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- * Individual vendor identifies as neurodivergent.
- * Organization is owned and/or operated by a neurodivergent individual.
- * Organization is an ND-affirming small business with less than 10 staff.

Why This Matters: Prioritizing ND-owned and ND-affirming small businesses can create opportunities for empowerment and economic participation that might otherwise be inaccessible to neurodivergent individuals.

Your Business, Your Way

Every business is different, and the ND Marketplace lets you choose how you want to participate. Whether you prefer a booth or a table spot, it's all happening in the same place, so there's no wrong way to join in!

During the application process, each vendor will select between one of two options:

Marketplace Booth (in person)

An exhibit space where vendors can actively sell, exchange, or display goods and services.

Includes:

- ~10' x 10' exhibit space
- One 8' table and two chairs
- Booth listing on Festival Map



Vendors are responsible for facilitating all financial transactions associated with the sale of their products and obtaining any necessary licensing or insurance.

Booth Set-Up & Tear-Down

Booths must be staffed and fully operational for the entirety of the festival; multiple attendants are permitted.

Set-Up Window:

• Sun. Oct. 13 from 10:30am-12:30pm

Tear-Down Window:

- Sun. Oct. 13 from 6:00pm-7:00pm
- No early dismantling is allowed!

Take One Table (drop off)

A dedicated spot where a vendor's promotional materials are left for attendees to view or take.

Includes:

- l' x l' reserved space on a prominently displayed table
- Material mail-in / drop-off options

All materials must be supplied by the vendor before the start of the festival, in a style and quantity of their choice, and not to exceed the allotted footprint.



Material Delivery Options

Pre-festival deliveries are subject to availability; material set-up and disposal will be handled by NDCF.

Festival Drop-Off:

Application Steps

Vendor spots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. The application deadline is **Monday, September 23, 2024**.

- * Step 1: Fill out the <u>ND Marketplace Vendor Application Form</u>. ONLINE ONLY!
- * Step 2: Once submitted, festival organizers will review your application and email you with their decision.
- * Step 3: If accepted, you'll be prompted to submit a payment to confirm your participation.
- * Step 4: Once your payment is received, you will be assigned a booth or exhibit number and given further instructions.

Vendor Agreement

Before beginning an application, please review the <u>NDCF 2024 Sponsor & Vendor Agreement</u>. You will be required to virtually sign it as part of your application.

► Step 1: Fill out this application by **Monday September 23**, **2024** *You will have the opportunity to choose between a Marketplace Booth or a Take One Table spot.*

Step 2: Festival organizers will review your application and email their decision.

▶ Step 3: If accepted, you will be prompted to submit a payment to confirm your participation. *The cost to participate in the ND Marketplace is \$25 and financial aid is available.*

Once your payment is received, you will be assigned a booth or exhibit number and given further instructions. Please note that vendor spots will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
